Apologies were given and accepted. The minutes of the Council meeting held on 14th September were agreed and approved.

<u>Matters Arising</u> – Membership work to be done by ACB was approved by the Council; this will certainly ease the workload for our Membership Secretary.

As you may remember from the last report, CoM members were asked to submit their timesheets for the hours they have voluntarily worked.
