Display and camping spaces will be allocated on arrival.

Please ask an organiser to show you to your allocated area before you set up

Please register details of any support vehicles on arrival including contact number

Support vehicle/trailer parking is available away from the display area

All safety notices, signs and instructions from marshals must be adhered to

All tents /displays should be equipped with a fire extinguisher/fire bucket and all guy ropes and pegs must be safe and marked

Noise must be kept at a reasonable level and minimised after 9pm and before 9am

Generators must not be used before 9am and after 9pm and RCDs should be used

BBQs etc are only permitted if raised off ground so lawns are not damaged

Displays must be safe and be supervised by a competent person from 10am-5pm

Any direct contact between vehicle/artefacts and the public must be carefully supervised

Vehicle movement should be minimised once displays are set up and a Marshal must supervise

Vehicles must be in a safe condition, carry a fire extinguisher and must be double chocked and safe for display
